ROCKLAND'S CULINARY SCENE

From the show grounds, you can see Rockland's three waterfront restaurants: The Pearl, Archer's on the Pier, and the **Landings Restaurant**. Each offers spectacular views coupled with freshly prepared seafood and a wide variety of other specialties.

Walk up the hill for the Time Out Pub, Hills Seafood, the Myrtle St. Tavern, and Park Street Grille. Continue toward the center of town, and you'll find Eclipse Restaurant and the Brass Compass (home of the King of Lobster club sandwich, winner of the Bobby Flay Throw-Down).

Wander to Oak St. to find Café Miranda, with an eclectic menu that's long on content and creativity (and a bathroom filled with Elvis memorabilia). Hand-crafted pastas and unique Italian fare are found at Rustica, and for an atmosphere of unhurried dining from full meals to light tapas, stop in at **In Good Company**. Farther down Main St., Sammy's Deluxe features a simple yet creative selection of menu items that changes daily.



Suzuki's is a *Boston Globe* recommendation for sushi. For an urban flair, Fog Bar & Café is tops for hip beverages and inspired menus. New this year is darn fine curry, which shares space with the Daily Perch (see breakfast). DFC's offerings can only be ordered at dfcurry.com; cash is not accepted.

Looking for pub fare? **Waterworks** on Lindsey Street, **Trackside Station** on Union Street, or the brewed-on-Main Street beers at **Rock Harbor Pub & Brewery** all fill the bill. For lighter fare, grab lunch at Clan MacLaren, or head to Wasses' Hot Dogs—a Rockland institution. Rock City Roasters & Café is home to locally roasted coffee and a unique menu of sandwiches and take out. Subs and burritos are found at Close to Home, and for breads and a fabulous selection of baked goods or ready-to-go sandwiches, Atlantic Baking Company has shelves and baskets filled to the brim. Home Sweet Home is Rockland's newest bakery. Other take-out options are Harborside Lunch,




the **Thai Tugboat** at the Ferry Terminal, **The Lobster Shack** on Main St., and **Claws** a bit farther north. When the show is not in residence, **Amato's** offers Italian fare in Buoy Park and the Thursday morning **Farmers' Market** takes place in Harbor Park.

Heading home to cook? Don't forget to check out **Main Street Market**'s take-out counter and their offerings of fresh produce and Maine food products. Heading toward Camden, the **Good Tern Coop**'s healthy and organic offerings are open to all. In the other direction, **Jess's Market** has just-off-the-boat seafood, and both **Wiggins Meat Market** and **Hops & Chops** are excellent choices for meat to take home for the grill.

To start the day right, Home Kitchen (also open for lunch), Rockland Café (open through dinner), the Daily Perch Café (breakfast, brunch, lunch), and the Brass Compass (breakfast and lunch) are local favorites. Hole in the Wall Bagel is another option farther north.





Sweet tooth? Who can resist a delish ice cream or gelato? Cone Home is just past the ferry terminal, Lulu's is on Oak Street, and Snow Drop Confections, Rocky's Frozen Treats, and Gelato Rose are all on Main Street. Dairy Queen on Park Street is another "go to" place for a cold treat on a hot day. Candy Harbor has a great selection of chocolate & candies.

For take-home culinary treats, swing by FIORE Artisan Olive Oils & Vinegars, or grab a Bixby & Co. chocolate bar at a

local shop. This special treat is manufactured just off Main Street.

It's a long walk (or short drive), but we'd be remiss to not mention **Primo Restaurant**. With a two-time James Beardaward-winning chef/owner and an on-site farm, you won't soon forget the farm-to-table experience there.

Can't decide? Join Maine Foodie Tours for a lunchtime culinary walking tour of Rockland and sample your way through the offerings at six local locations.

Midcoast Maine, and especially Rockland, has become a magnet for artists and artisans of all stripes—the creative economy is alive and well here. On most any given day, especially in high summer, there are loads of opportunities to get in touch with the region's creative spirit.

The downtown Rockland gallery scene is a particularly lively one. Main Street is lined with galleries and a **First Friday Art Walk** kicks off each month (www.artsinrockland.org). New to Rockland (but not to the region) is the

Center for Maine Contemporary Art.

CMCA moved from their long-time home in Rockport into cutting edge purpose-built digs at 21 Winter Street designed by Toshiko Mori (cmcanow.org). The contemporary and gallery art scenes are complemented by the offerings at the Farnsworth Art Museum, which celebrates Maine's considerable role in American art, has one of the nation's largest collections of works by sculptor Louise Nevelson, and features works by Andrew, N.C., and Jamie Wyeth. One might say that the Farnsworth began it all; it has been a downtown anchor on Main Street since 1948 (www.farnsworthmuseum.org).

Interested in the performing arts? At the lovingly restored **Strand Theatre** on Main Street, world-class and local performers share the stage with art films

and new movie releases (www.rocklandstrand.com). Saturday, August 12, the New-York based French Pop + Latin + Jazz group Banda Magda will perform at 7:30 p.m. **Bay Chamber Concerts** presents mainly classical music at the Strand as well as at venues in nearby Camden and Rockport. **The North Atlantic Blues** Festival brings big-name blues artists to Harbor Park each July, and the Lobster Festival in early August also features live music. To help tie it all together, Rockland Main Street organizes an annual Summer Solstice celebration (June) and the Festival of Lights (November) (www.rocklandmainstreet.com).
